Disclaimer

The main duties are on Sundays when we cover the three main daytime

services which are:

9am Eucharist in the retro choir; 11am Sung Eucharist in the Nave; 3pm Evensong also in the Nave.

We have 4 teams of up to 10 people to cover the 11am and 2 people for the 9am and 3pm Sunday services.

There are also many other services during the week which need stewards. We steward for Diocesan services such as Confirmations, Ordinations and special services.

We ask the volunteers to commit to at least two services per month.
